Now I had to make some hard decisions regarding team selection at times, but this was done in my opinion with the clubs and teams best interest at heart. Some might disagree with my decisions and that's fine, but it is easy to give an opinion from the outside when you don't know the full situation and are not privy to all the conversations that took place.

In my opinion we were lucky to make the final of the Summer Cup (for a second year in succession) and getting beat the way we did showed us all how far behind we were in preparation, due to the fact that numbers at pre-season training was limited.
